

College Credit Plus at Ohio State ATI: The Academy Program



CCP Admission Requirement for 2024-25:

Test-Optional Admission **OR**
Students without a standardized test should meet the following criteria:

- Unweighted high school academic GPA of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale, not including non-academic classes)
- 2 years *each* of high school English and math

Note: OSU placement testing may also be required of admitted students prior to CCP Orientation and scheduling.

Standardized Test Admission
Students who do not meet the test-optional criteria can be admitted based on meeting standardized test scores in English, reading, and mathematics:

- ACT scores of 18 in English, 22 in Reading, and 22 in Mathematics.
- SAT scores of 480 in Evidence Based Reading & Writing, and 530 in Math.
- ACCUPLACER scores of 263 in Writing, 250 in Reading, and 263 in Math.

Academy Application Process (ati.osu.edu/academy):

1. Online Application at go.osu.edu/academyapp (Create an account; then select the College Credit Plus/ Academy application. If you are asked to pay a fee, you are using the wrong application.)
2. Official transcript of coursework emailed to ESUE-studugt@osu.edu
3. Test scores from the ACT, SAT, or ACCUPLACER test. Note: Admission to the Academy will be test-optional for the 2024-2025 academic year.
4. School Information Form downloaded from the Academy website, signed by your school counselor or principal, and emailed to ESUE-studugt@osu.edu
5. Mature Content Permission Slip completed by the student and parent and emailed directly to ESUE-studugt@osu.edu. A link to this form is emailed to you immediately after you apply.

Application Timeline and Deadlines:

- Submit "Intent to Participate" form to your school by April 1
- **Autumn Semester Application Deadline: May 1**
 - Mature Content Permission Deadline: May 31
- **Spring Semester Application Deadline: October 15**
 - Mature Content Permission Deadline: November 1
- **Non-Public and Home School Students:** If you wish to apply for state funding, you must complete the Academy application no later than March 1 and apply for state funding by 5 p.m. April 1. Visit www.ohiohighered.org/ccp for additional info.
- After you apply, you will receive an email with your OSU ID and username (lastname.#). Follow the instructions to complete the Mature Content permission slip and activate your OSU username and password.

Testing Details:

- Students who do not meet the test-optional admission criteria can be admitted based on meeting standardized test scores in English, reading, and mathematics.
- You can submit ACT, SAT, or ACCUPLACER scores for review, if desired.
- Students admitted *without* test scores will be required to complete English and math placement tests prior to course scheduling, which may impact the students' course eligibility. (For example, you might be admitted without restrictions yet not be able to test into college-level English or math during placement testing. Remedial level courses are not covered by CCP funding.)
- Placement testing is completed *after* admission, during orientation, using an Ohio State placement test, not the ACCUPLACER test.
- Details about ACCUPLACER testing:
 - If you plan to include ACCUPLACER test scores in your application, you must first apply for CCP admission and submit your high school transcripts to Ohio State before ACCUPLACER testing can be approved.
 - Once you are approved for testing (if it is necessary in your application):
 - ◊ Contact the Ohio State ATI testing center at (330) 287-1258 if you have taken no standardized tests previously, OR
 - ◊ Contact the OSU Mansfield testing center at (419) 755-4133 (or online at go.osu.edu/mansccp) if you have already taken an ACT, SAT, or ACCUPLACER test.
 - ◊ Reminder: your CCP application and transcripts must be received by Ohio State *before* ACCUPLACER testing can be authorized.
- We cannot accept ACCUPLACER test results from any institution other than The Ohio State University.
- Ohio State does not use the ACCUPLACER test for course placement.

Class Scheduling:

- Admission does not guarantee enrollment in a specific course.
- Advising and class selection occur at Orientation during July (or mid-December for Spring Semester).
- Limited online courses are available at Ohio State ATI; some online courses are offered synchronously with in-person classes.
- Currently no summer course options are available for ATI Academy students.
- Academy courses establish your Ohio State transcript; your GPA will follow you.
- Credit hours taken through the Academy do not count in the hours needed to transition to the Columbus campus of Ohio State if you later apply for freshman admission to the Columbus campus and are deferred to a regional campus or ATI.
