

## COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP MAJOR – COMMUNITY & EXTENSION EDUCATION SPECIALIZATION (A.S.) INTERESTED IN COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP MAJOR – COMMUNITY & EXTENSION EDUCATION SPECIALIZATION (B.S.)

This model plan of study is presented as a suggested path to graduate in 4 years with an Associate of Science Degree with a major in Community Leadership and specialization in Community & Extension Education and a Bachelor of Science Degree in Agriculture with a major in Community Leadership and a specialization in Community & Extension Education. It is intended to be a useful guide; however, each student is unique and should review the Degree Requirements and work with their advisor to develop an individualized course plan that best fits their personal academic background and goals.
